Well, here we are in week 11 of a 12-week term. We have noticed a lot of sicknesses this week, including colds, headaches and sore throats. Earlier in the week, we had 80 learners away from school! Thanks for helping to keep other learners fit and healthy by keeping any children who are unwell at home.

We are definitely noticing that tiredness is hitting many of our learners. A long term, coupled with a very unsettling year has taken a toll on some. From a wellbeing perspective, we are noticing that some of our kids have more 'worries' than usual. Some of these are big worries - about COVID returning, or about family members potentially losing their jobs. It is important for children to have the opportunity to discuss things that they are worried about, and our focus on Mindfulness allows this to happen. It's important to make space in our curriculum to ensure that our kids are settled and open to new learning. We have also been focused on gratitude, as talking about and sharing the things that we are grateful for is a powerful tool for creating positive thoughts and feelings. Next term, we will be adding wellbeing updates to our newsletter, so that you can join in with whatever our focus has been at school.


Trivia Night - Saturday 5 September 7pm until late
